***Rules & Regulations***

- \*\* ABSOLUTELY NO USE OF PRESSURE WASHERS IN TENT AREA \*\***
1. ***Exhibitors must have their horses in the ring on time!***
  2. This is a registered show. Registration papers are NOT required for Classes 1, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20 & 28.
  3. No more than 2 entries per exhibitor may be shown in one class of a sub section.
  4. All exhibitors must display a stall card with exhibitors name, address and breed of horse exhibited.
  5. Please fill out the stall requirement form and return it with your entry.

6. All exhibitors entering the show ring are required to wear suitable show clothing and footwear.
7. Horses must be properly groomed and cared for while stabled at Old Home Week.  
***Failure to do so may result in a 1 year suspension from exhibiting from this exhibition.***
8. Judges are required to avoid awarding premiums to unsound horses.
9. Old Home Week reserves the right to restrict entries for draft horses show in Hitch Classes. The first 25 entries in each breed are guaranteed stabling in the Horse Dome.
10. ***All entry forms are to be accompanied by proof of liability insurance coverage.***
11. If draft horse breed and team class entries are 3 or less on the closing date of entries, classes and breeds may be combined.
12. Youth Hitch/Cart entries must be ***accompanied by an adult.*** Entrants in the ***Youth Hitch/ Cart Classes cannot enter in the Ladies Team/Cart Classes.*** Youth Hitch/ Cart for Ages 5-16.
13. In the showmanship classes, a contestant will only be permitted to enter 1 breed.
14. No long whips are allowed in the Show Ring.
15. DEFINITION OF A BROOD MARE: is a mare that shows evidence of being in foal or has raised a foal in current year. The exhibitor is required to show the mare with foal at foot OR registration certificate of the foal OR vet's certificate of deceased foal must be provided if foal is not shown.
16. **UPON DEPARTURE, ALL STALLS MUST BE CLEANED OF MANURE & BEDDING AND TRANSPORTED TO THE DUMPSTER -FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN FOREFEITURE OF ALL PRIZE MONEY -**

17. No vehicles left parked on the grounds after 10am, or vehicle will be towed at owners expense
18. Progeny of Dam, Get of Sire, and Island Bred & Owned must be shown in their respective age line class to enter
19. All horses must be stabled in OHW tent for duration of show (NO SHOWING OFF TRAILER) If stable space is full by entry closing date, special arrangements may be made for line class exhibitors
20. Priority for stabling will be given to hitch horses

Please note the following rules for the Bareback class

- There is no fee to enter this class. All entries must complete a registration form by entry deadline
- Entries not showing in hitch/line classes must make arrangements with the OHW office prior to show day for arrival/departure if stabling is not required
- All competitors **MUST** wear a helmet approved by the judge. This helmet will include but not limited to a proper riding helmet, or other headgear such as hockey helmets or bicycle helmets. No vehicle helmets considered to be “full face” will be permitted.
- All owners/riders must have complete control in handling and manners of their horse while on the grounds and during the class. Participants may be asked to leave on request of the judge or committee member of the PEI Provincial Exhibition Inc if it is felt they are a danger to themselves or others
- It is understood that entries in this class will not hold responsible for any loss or injury the PEI Draft Horse Association or PEI Provincial Exhibition while on the grounds or participating in this class
- Class will proceed at judge’s discretion – it may include walk/trot on the rail or an obstacle course. There will be **NO** cantering/galloping in the class.
- There is no limit to the number of entries per owner.
- Prizes will be presented at the end of the class
