Notes for Competitors

- A. Entries are due no later than **August 1st, 2016**. There will be a late entry fee of \$20.00 after this date.
- B. Entries will **NOT** be accepted on the day of the show.
- C. All exhibitors must have Island Horse Council Insurance.
- D. One entry per horse/handler combination must be submitted.
- E. Entry fees are \$7.00/class for up to 7 classes or \$50.00 for 8 or more classes. This does not include stake classes or the charity relay class.
- F. There will be a number fee of \$5.00 per entry, unless you have already purchased a number through PEIMHA. Your fee will be returned when your number is handed in.
- G. Competitors will be required to pay at the gate and for parking. Week-long passes for Old Home Week are available for sale through the Old Home Week Office, www.oldhomeweekpei.ca for details.
- H. Horses entered in PEI Miniature Horse Association shows must be registered with either the American Miniature Horse Association, the American Miniature Horse Registry or the World Class Miniature Horse Registry.
- I. PEI Miniature Horse Association follows the rules and regulations of the American Miniature Horse Registry.
- J. Horses may arrive on site Wednesday August 10th, 2016 after 6:00pm. There will be no charge to the competitors for stabling.
- K. We have a limited number of stalls available. It will be necessary for individuals entering more than one horse to share a box stall.
- L. Competitors are responsible for bringing their own shavings and for completely cleaning out their stall. You must remove all bedding (clean and dirty). Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of your prize money.
- M. **There are no dogs permitted on the exhibition grounds.** Assistance dogs are welcome.
- N. There is no smoking permitted in the horse dome.
- O. Please notify the announcer of any tack changes before the show begins for the day. Once the class is called and competitors begin entering the ring, all competitors have 3 minutes to enter. After this the gate will be closed.
- P. **The judge's decision is final.**
- Q. The **Youth** Division is open to all competitors 17 years of age and under as of January 1st, 2016. Youth are required to wear helmets during all driving classes, and this is strongly encouraged for adults as well.
- R. Open Stake Classes are open to all competitors at the show. There is an entry fee of \$10.00 per stake class. Entry fees will be divided among the top five places as followed: 1st place=30%, 2nd place=25%, 3rd place=20%, 4th place=15%, 5th place=10%.
- S. The **Peewee** Division is open to children ages 6 and under. This division includes a showmanship class and a lead-line (riding) class. Participants must wear helmets and safe footwear. There will be a prize for every entry.
- T. **Versatility** is a class that combines pleasure driving, halter and hunter. The class will begin with pleasure driving, following which the competitor has 2 minutes to un-tack their horse and prepare for the halter portion. The competitors will then be asked to take two hunter jumps.
- U. The **Green Horse** Pleasure Driving Class is open to any horse that has never been entered in a driving class. Entries in this class cannot enter any other driving classes.

- V. The **High Jump** Class is an elimination class. There will be two jumps – one will stay the same height and the second will be raised each round. Every competitor takes turns clearing the jumps as the height is raised. Competitors will have two attempts to clear the jump before elimination. Competitors are eliminated by refusals and knockdowns until only one competitor remains.
- W. The **Charity Relay** is a timed event that will be completed in teams of two horse/handler combinations. One team member will be hitched in cart and completes a set of obstacles. When they cross the finish line their partner will complete a set of jumps and when they cross the finish line time is stopped. You can enter with a partner or as an individual and we will pair you up. The entry fee is \$10.00/person. The pot will be donated to the winning team's charity of choice. This is a youth/adult combined event. Feel free to dress up, think of a team name and have fun!
- X. Grand Champion and Reserve Champion prizes will be awarded as follows:
- a. **Grand Champion Halter Horse**
 - i. Top 2 places from all halter classes will participate in a class to choose the top halter horse.
 - b. **Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Youth**
 - i. Points will be combined from Youth Showmanship, Obstacle Driving, Obstacle in Hand, Pleasure Driving and Roadster to determine Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Youth.
 - c. **Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Adult**
 - i. Points will be combined from Youth Showmanship, Obstacle Driving, Obstacle in Hand, Pleasure Driving and Roadster to determine Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Youth.
 - d. **Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Youth Games**
 - i. Points will be combined from Youth Poles, Barrels, Hunter and Jumper to determine Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Youth Games.
 - e. **Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Adult Games**
 - i. Points will be added from Adult Poles, Barrels, Hunter and Jumper to determine Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Adult Games.
