### Rules & Regulations

1. The shows are recognized as a purebred show and as such, Registrations will be governed by the Livestock Rules & Regulations in this book.

- 2. All dairy breeds must have no less than 3 exhibitors and 24 animals on the closing date for entries. Dairy entries are limited to 10 animals per breed per exhibitor.
- 3. Exhibitors, who do not keep their stalls and animals clean will be called to the OHW office and will be given 2 hours to improve conditions with further penalties if it is not cleaned up. The final penalty will be a *I year suspension* from exhibiting at Old Home Week.
- 4. Dairy Exhibitors will be requested to wear suitable, clean clothing and footwear at all times. All Exhibitors are requested to dress in white clothing and wear hat band numbers in the show ring.
- 5. Stall cards showing performance information is required and must be properly completed and displayed in the livestock area for each individual animal exhibited.
- 6. 4-H members are permitted to entry their 4-H project animal, which may not be their property, in the open show.
- 7. No single animal may be shown in more than 1 class except for a championship, special prize, or in the best udder class. To be eligible for a group class, every member of the group must be exhibited in its appropriate class for single animals.
- 8. Milk Tank & Technician: There will be a milk tank and technician on site. Exhibitors who contaminate the milk tank shall be penalized and will be charged for both the full value of the milk in the tank and disposing of the contaminated milk.
