**Old Home Week Beef Cattle**

***Rules & Regulations***

1. The Shows are recognized as a Purebred Show and as such, registrations will be governed by Livestock Rules and Regulations found at the beginning of this book.
2. All beef breeds must have no less than 3 exhibitors and 12 animals on the closing date for entries.
3. Calves born January 1, 2025 will be permitted to show with their dams in Classes 7 and 8, as well as separately in designated calf classes.
4. Nurse Cows will not be permitted; however, 2025 beef calves will be allowed to show. These calves may leave each night after 8pm and must be returned by 8am each morning. 2025 calves which fall under this rule must be identified on the Livestock Entry Form.
5. Exhibitors who do not keep their stalls and animals clean will be called to the OHW office and will be given 2 hours to improve conditions. Further penalties will result should this not occur. The final penalty will be a 1 year suspension from exhibiting at Old Home Week.
6. Beef exhibitors will be requested to wear suitable clean clothing and footwear at all times. Breed colors are requested for the show ring.
7. Stall cards showing performance information is required and must be properly completed and displayed in the livestock area for each individual animal exhibited.
8. Clipping chutes will be in a designated area. Each exhibitor will be allotted space for 1 chute.
9. 4-H members are permitted to enter their 4-H project animal, which may not be their property, in the open show.
10. In beef classifications, there are no restriction on multiple exhibits excluding Classes 11 & 12, where only 1 exhibit per exhibitor is permitted.
11. Premier Breeder: This award will be offered to the individual partnership of firm - as recorded on the certificate of registration at the time of entry - having the highest number of points based on a maximum of the six highest placing animals in Classes 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8, bred by the breeder. In the case of jointly bred animals, no points awarded will count towards the individual score of any of the joint breeders. Points will be awarded as follows:  
1<sup>st</sup> - 7 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5 points, 4<sup>th</sup> - 4 points, 5<sup>th</sup> - 3 points, 6<sup>th</sup> - 1 point  
In the event of a tie, the award shall go to the breeder that places higher in Class 12, Breeders Herd Class.
12. Premier Exhibitor: This award will be offered to the individual, partnership of firm - as recorded on the certificate of registration at the time of entry - having the highest number of points based on a maximum of the six highest placing animals in Classes 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8, owned by that exhibitor. To be eligible for this award, the exhibitor must exhibit 5 animals at the show. Points will be awarded as follows:  
1<sup>st</sup> - 7 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5 points, 4<sup>th</sup> - 4 points, 5<sup>th</sup> - 3 points, 6<sup>th</sup> - 2 points, 7<sup>th</sup> - 1 point  
In the event of a tie, the award shall go to the breeder that places higher in Class 12, Breeders Herd Class.
13. Due to limited space, OHW Management reserves the right to reduce or refuse entries.

***The exhibitor of an animal must meet all 3 of the following criteria:***

1. Be the sole owner or in case of jointly owned, as per the certificate of the registration of the animal at entry time.
2. Have duly entered and paid for the entry of the said animal for the show.
3. Have the animal in his/her possession and in his/her exhibit at the show.

**Please Note: Both Angus Shows (Open/Gold Show and Futurity) will be non-aerosol/non-pressurized can shows**

- Class 11 Get of Sire - a group of 3 animals from the same sire with both sexes represented. At least 1 animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous classes Prize Money: 1st \$47, 2nd \$35, 3rd \$24, 4th \$12
- Class 12 Breeder's Herd - a group of 4 animals bred by the exhibitor with both sexes represented. At least 1 animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous classes. - Rosettes
- Class 13 Progeny of Dam - Rosettes Only
